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## Department 12 Rules

1. **Pre-enter by proper class and description.**
2. If there is a question that a certain item will be ready or not at fair time, pre-enter anyway.
3. Exhibit removal time starts at 8:00pm on the last day of the fair.
4. Exhibits remaining after the allotted removal time will be considered abandoned and discarded.
5. Entries are limited to one per class per exhibitor
6. Index size informational cards describing exhibit (variety, uses, seed company, etc..) are encouraged.

**HAY**

Premiums: 1<sup>st</sup> - \$5.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$4.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$3.00 - 4<sup>th</sup> -

### Class Descriptions:

1. **Hybrid-Field Corn - (3 ears) Husk Off**
  - A. Open Pollinated
    1. Field Corn (white, yellow or red)
    2. Ornamental Corn (colored)
      - a. Harvested current year
      - b. Harvested one year prior
    3. Tallest Stalk (1 stalk, not husked)
  - B. Popcorn - 3 ears
    1. Harvested current year
    2. Harvested one year prior
2. **Corn** - 3 stalks to be displayed
  - A. Field
  - B. Silage
3. **Sunflowers** - Include stalk and flower
  - A. Over 5 feet - measured from ground to crook of head
  - B. Under 5 feet - measured from ground to crook of head
  - C. Multiple Flower Heads
  - D. Flower only (under 10" diameter)
  - E. Flower Only (over 10" diameter)
4. **Oats** - in quart jar
  - A. Clintland 64 or Clintford
  - B. Garry
  - C. Pennfield
  - D. Russell
  - E. Orbit
  - F. Others not listed judged in one group
5. **Wheat** - in quart jar
  - A. Pennoll
  - B. Redcoat
  - C. Others not listed judged in one group
6. **Miscellaneous** - in quart jar
  - A. Alfalfa
  - B. Buckwheat
    1. Japanese or Silverfull
    2. Pennquad
  - C. Soybean
  - D. Sunflower seed
  - E. Timothy Seed
  - F. Corn
  - G. Red Clover Seed
  - H. Rye
  - I. Popcorn
  - J. Others not listed judged in one group

### Rules & Regulations:

**Long hay only. An exhibit of 6-8" in thickness tied together, not in a bag.**

### Class Descriptions:

1. **Alfalfa or Alfalfa Grass Mixed**, not over 50% of grasses.
  - A. First cutting.
  - B. Later cuttings.
2. **Other Legumes or Legume Grass Mixtures**, not over 50% of grasses.
3. **Grass** - Mixtures of Timothy and/or other grasses and containing not more than 10% legumes.
  - A. First cutting.
  - B. Second cutting.
4. **Legume other than Alfalfa** - second cutting, not more than 50% grasses.
5. **Mixed Hay** - any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contains 50% or more singly or in combination of Alfalfa, Timothy, Clover and Grasses.
6. **Summer Annual Grasses** - Sudan grass, Sorghum-Sudan, hybrids, etc.
7. **Straw**
  - A. Wheat
  - B. Oat

## SECTION 3

**Silage**

Premiums: 1<sup>st</sup> - \$5.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$4.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$3.00 - 4<sup>th</sup> - \$2.00

**Silage crop must be named. Exhibits shall consist of 10 pounds** (Large size plastic bags are excellent containers for transporting or showing samples.)

### Class Descriptions:

1. **Perennial crops**
  - A. Direct cut, with or without preservative.
  - B. Wilted or low moisture, with or without preservative.
2. **Annuals other than corn**
  - A. Direct cut, with or without preservative.
  - B. Wilted or low moisture, with or without preservative.
3. **Corn Silage**
4. **High Moisture Corn**
