RULES:

- All participants are expected to compete in a fair manner and abide by all rules. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and can result in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of any entry fees or awards.
- A panel of event superintendents will review all scenarios not specifically covered by published rules. All decisions by superintendents are final without appeal.
- Everyone competing and/or operating an ATV is required to wear a DOT helmet, eye protection (glasses, goggles, face shield), long-sleeved shirt, long pants and closed-toed shoes. Other protective gear is strongly recommended.
- Stock and modified machines are permitted with any tire size. Paddles, chains and spikes are not permitted. Natural aspiration only. No nitrous oxide and no nitro methane may be used.
- All youth class units must be factory stock..NO MODS.**
- Insurance and registration is highly recommended.
- ATV's may be inspected at any time by event officials.
- Participants may enter more than one event in each class, but may enter each event only once. ATVs may be used by no more than two (2) competitors.

- Operators must stay on their machine during the run; dismounting from the machine terminates the run, unless otherwise instructed in the event description or event official.
- ATVs cannot be ridden outside of the track area and pits. Speed limit 5mph strictly enforced.
- **NEW**** - No youth class and adult class riders permitted on the track at the same time.
- In case of breakdown, riders are responsible for hooking the towrope to his/her machine; any and all damages incurred when being towed are the sole responsibility of the rider.
- The Waterford Community Fair, it's committees including volunteers and event /track personnel and officials are not responsible for accidents, injury or theft to property. **Personal ATV insurance and registration is highly recommended.**
- Non-compliance with the rules of this event or general rules of the fair may result in disqualification, expulsion and forfeiture of all prizes.
- Scoring rules and descriptions for each ATV Rodeo event will be distributed at the drivers meeting on the date of the rodeo.
- All adult class riders must be at least 16 years of age, 12 years of age with adult waiver.

FARM TRACTOR PULL

Entry Fee - \$10.00

SATURDAY - SEPTEMBER 6, 2025

Weigh-In at Waterford Fairgrounds from 10:00am - 11:30am

RULES:

- Open to any farm tractor on rubber tires.
- Tractors will pull from weight transfer machine.
- Tractors will pull on a dirt track.
- Dual tires, tire studs or chains are not permitted.
- Weights, such as concrete blocks, anvils, railroad irons, high-lifts, log chains, etc. will be barred from the contest in the interest of safety.
- No excessive spinning will be allowed, particularly after the load cannot be moved. (Judges decision is final in this manner.)
- In case of dispute on weight, the disputed winner must be weighed out.
- Driver must remain seated at all times.
- All pulls must start from a tight hitch. **NO JERKING ALLOWED.**
10. Tractors must remain within boundaries of contest course during the pull or will be disqualified.
- All operators must be at least 16 years of age.
- The Fair Board will not be responsible for any accidents.
- All contestants will be assigned a number to be displayed on the tractor.
- Judges have the right to stop and disqualify any tractor being operated in an unsafe manner.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages prior to pulling will mean disqualification.
- All tractors must be in neutral or park (transmission selector) while being hitched or unhitched.
- Contestant must pull at position drawn; any delay will mean disqualification, unless notice is given to judges, contestant will then pull last.

CLASSES:

Non-Turbo 4,000 lbs. - 5,000 lbs. - 7,000 lbs. - 9,000 lbs.
Turbo 5,000 lbs. - 7,000 lbs. - 9,000 lbs. - 12,000 lbs. - 13,500 lbs. - 15,500 lbs.

PRIZES: 1st - \$50.00 2nd - \$40.00 3rd - \$30.00 4th - \$20.00 5th - \$10.00

**Trophies to be awarded for 1st and 2nd place in each class
Ribbons for each prize.**

- Draw bar to be stationary in all directions, 20" from top of draw bar, parallel to the ground.
- Tractors may jump one class.
- Non-turbo tractors may elect to pull in turbo class but may only pull in two classes total.
- First puller in each class may forfeit first pull, then pull sixth.
- All rules subject to change.
- No tractor can exceed 3000 rpm. Can be checked at any time if judges question tractor rpm.

Lightweight 35HP & Under
Heavyweight 36HP & Over

PRIZES: 1st - \$50.00 2nd - \$40.00 3rd - \$30.00 4th - \$20.00

TRACTORS PULL IN ONE CLASS ONLY

GENERAL RULES:

- Contest open to an 2-wheel or 4-wheel drive compact tractor.
- Compact/Sub-compact tractor defined as of the compact build, not a small farm tractor.
- 4-wheel drive use permitted.
- Enter it as you use it – loaders permitted.
