SECTION 1 - WINES

Premiums: 1st - \$11.00; 2nd-\$9.00; 3rd-\$6.00

DEPARTMENT 21 RULES:

HOMEMADE WINE

1. This is an amateur competition.
2. Only one entry (one bottle) per class per entrant.
3. All wines must be produced and bottled by the entrant, made from grapes, grape concentrate, fruit, fruit juice, honey, vegetables, grains, blossoms or other fermentable. Wine may NOT be blended with commercial wines.
4. University of California Davis 20-point scoring system will be used.

HOMEMADE BEER

1. Open to Pennsylvania Residents only.
2. Brew must be shown in glass bottles, 7 to 32 oz. with crown cap.
3. An exhibitor may enter up to 3 home brews, but only 1 per class..
4. Bottles and caps must be free of identifying markings..
5. Judging will be based on aroma, appearance, flavor, mouthfeel and overall impressions, using American Homebrewers Assn. scoresheet.

DEPARTMENT 23 RULES:

1. NO EXHIBITOR IDENTIFICATION LABELS ARE ALLOWED ON BOTTLES OR CONTAINERS PRIOR TO JUDGING. LABELS CAN BE ADDED AFTER JUDGING
2. Exhibit Removal time starts at 8:00pm on the last day of the fair.
3. Entries are limited to one class per exhibitor

APIARY PRODUCTS

1. Class 1 to be judged on uniformity of color, bees, presence of queen, brood, and honey, cleanliness, and appearance of observation hive.
2. Comb honey to be judged of perfection in filling, capped uniformity, neatness, and cleanliness of section.
3. Extracted honey to be judged on body, clarity and cleanliness.
4. Beeswax to be judged on color and purity.

MAPLE PRODUCTS:

1. Syrup and sugar to be judged on flavor, appearance and texture

SECTION 1 APIARY PRODUCTS

Premiums: 1st - \$6.00; 2nd-\$5.00; 3rd-\$4.00; 4th-\$3.00

Class Descriptions:

1. **Bees, any race. One frame observation hive.**
2. **Honey**
 - A. Light comb, 1 section
 - B. Dark comb, 1 section
 - C. Light extracted honey, 1 one-pound or 1 pint jar
 - D. Amber extracted honey, 1 one-pound or 1 pint jar
 - E. Dark amber extracted honey, 1 one-pound or 1 pint jar
 - F. Finely crystallized honey, 1 one-pound or 1 pint jar
3. **Beeswax, not less than three pounds**
4. **Collective exhibit of honey, wax, home products, and bees.**

SECTION 2 MAPLE SYRUP AND MAPLE PRODUCTS

Premiums: 1st - \$6.00; 2nd-\$5.00; 3rd-\$4.00; 4th-\$3.00

Class Descriptions:

1. **Maple Syrup**
 - A. Syrup (pint size, any type container)
 1. Golden
 2. Amber
 3. Dark
 4. Very Dark
 - B. Novice Class - any size and container
For the novice producing less than 10 gallons of maple syrup during the season
2. **Maple Products**
 - A. Maple sugar, 1/4 pound or larger
 - B. Maple cream, 1/4 pound or larger
 - C. Maple candy, soft, small individual cakes, not less than 1/4 pound
 - D. Maple Mustards, sauces
 - E. Miscellaneous Maple Products - fudge, butter, coated items, taffy, etc.
3. **Collective Exhibit** - At least 4 different maple syrup or maple products attractively displayed. Products in this class cannot compete in any other classes.
