CLASSES:

Non-Turbo 4,000 lbs. - 5,000 lbs. - 7,000 lbs. - 9,000 lbs.
Turbo 5,000 lbs. - 7,000 lbs. - 9,000 lbs. - 12,000 lbs. - 13,500 lbs. - 15,500 lbs.

PRIZES: 1st - \$50.00 2nd - \$40.00 3rd - \$30.00 4th - \$20.00 5th - \$10.00
Trophies to be awarded for 1st and 2nd place in each class
Ribbons for each prize.

RULES:

- Open to any farm tractor on rubber tires.
- Tractors will pull from weight transfer machine.
- Tractors will pull on a dirt track.
- Dual tires, tire studs or chains are not permitted.
- Weights, such as concrete blocks, anvils, railroad irons, high-lifts, log chains, etc. will be barred from the contest in the interest of safety.
- No excessive spinning will be allowed, particularly after the load cannot be moved. (Judges decision is final in this manner.)
- In case of dispute on weight, the disputed winner must be weighed out.
- Driver must remain seated at all times.
- All pulls must start from a tight hitch. **NO JERKING ALLOWED.**
- Tractors must remain within boundaries of contest course during the pull will be disqualified.
- All operators must be at least 16 years of age.
- The Fair Board will not be responsible for any accidents.
- All contestants will be assigned a number to be displayed on the tractor.
- Judges have the right to stop and disqualify any tractor being operated in an unsafe manner.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages prior to pulling will mean disqualification.
- All tractors must be in neutral or park (transmission selector) while being hitched or unhitched.
- Contestant must pull at position drawn; any delay will mean disqualification, unless notice is given to judges, contestant will then pull last.
- Draw bar to be stationary in all directions, 20" from top of draw bar, parallel to the ground.
- Tractors may jump one class.
- Non-turbo tractors may elect to pull in turbo class but may only pull in two classes total.
- First puller in each class may forfeit first pull, then pull sixth.
- All rules subject to change.
- No tractor can exceed 3000 rpm. Can be checked at any time if judges question tractor rpm.

RULES:

- Open to any farm tractor on rubber.
- No tractor can be newer than 1962 model year.
- Rear tires can be no more than 2 sizes over factory dimensions. **Note: If challenged by track officials, the burden of proof is the responsibility of the driver of the tractor in question.**
- No engine modifications and/or governor alterations.
- Tractor draw bars must be able to hook to dyno.
- No jumping classes.
- Maximum draw bar height:
Classes 2500# to 5000# - 17"
Classes 5500# & up - 20"
and stationary in all directions.
- Tractors will be weighed in at fairgrounds at 3:00 pm and close at 6:15 pm
- No hang-on weights.
- All decisions of officials are final. Arguing with judges could result in disqualification and no return of hook fee.
- Engine must run at stock RPM. The Nebraska Tractor test book - 1950 thru 1975 will be used.
- No more than 10% horsepower over original rating will be accepted.
- Tractor must remain in bounds or will be disqualified.
- All rules are subject to change.**
- Tractor Draw bar must have a 3" minimum diameter clevis.
- No spacing between draw bar and hitch plate or D-Rings to achieve hitch height of 1" or more.
- No throttle linkage adjustments. Must be original equipment.
