RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All sheep exhibited must be accompanied by an official certificate of health signed by a licensed veterinarian indicating they have inspected the flock of which the animals are a part and found them free from scabies and other transmissible diseases.
- Entries must be postmarked by August 22.
- All entries must be mailed with a check made payable to The Waterford Fair Association, **\$2.00 per animal** to: **Morgan Kingen, 2510 Stone Quarry Road, Waterford, PA 16441**. Entries mailed without the entry fee will be returned. No phone nor hand delivered entries will be accepted.
- Total number of entries and number of entries per exhibitor may be limited due to available space.
- All animals must meet the health requirements described in the health certification of the fair book. All animals with the exceptions of market animals must have breed registration papers.
- All animals must be entered in accordance with Fair regulations by 9:00pm Sunday preceding the fair.
- Open class judging is scheduled for Tuesday at 5:00pm. Market classes are scheduled for 6:00pm
- No animals can be removed before 7:00am Sunday morning. Animals must be removed 10:00am to allow for clean up.
- All exhibits will be under the control and direction of the livestock committee, but the Fair Association will in no case be responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to, or occasioned by, or arising from any animal exhibited by the exhibitor.

All livestock exhibits (including out of state entries) must have current "Certificate of Veterinary Inspection" (CVI) form.

Pennsylvania Sheep — CVI issued after May 1, current year.
Out of State Sheep — CVI issued within the 30 days prior to the date of importation.

SECTION 2 MARKET SHEEP

Limit 1 market lamb per exhibitor.

Market lamb must be female or castrated male and weigh a minimum of 80 lbs. and maximum of 170 lbs. All lambs must be dry, sheared and without coats or tights at weigh-in.

Market Sheep will be divided into nearly equal class or sub-class by the Department Chairs and their representatives at their discretion. There will be a maximum of nine classes/sub-classes with a minimum of four animals per class/sub-class.
